## Logistics: Vilnius Airport ➔ Vilnius City Center

Getting from the airport to the city center by car takes about 15 minutes. There are several convenient ways to reach the city center from the airport:

- **Bolt** ride-hailing service. Bolt offers a taxi service that you can use by downloading the Bolt app to your phone and ordering a ride. It is safe, quick, easy and cheap.
- **Public transportation**. Buses **3G** and **88** run from the airport to the city center. We recommend exiting at *Vinco Kudirkos aikštė* or *Žalioji tiltas*. Information about Vilnius public transportation, including schedules and routes, is available on the **Traffi** app, where tickets can also be purchased. Alternatively, passengers may buy a ticket on board by tapping a contactless bank card on the ticket validator.

## Thursday | May 22

### (Network Members' Dinner)

The members' dinner of the International Network for Social Policy Teaching and Research will take place at **Mano Guru** restaurant, located at 20 Vilniaus Street, Vilnius. The dinner will start at **18:30** local time.

## Friday | May 23

### (Annual Network Meeting and First Day of the Conference)

- **Venue**. The annual meeting and conference will be held at **Vilnius University's Central Campus, in the Aula Parva Hall**. The Central Campus is located in the center of Vilnius – at 3 Universiteto Street.
- **Coffee breaks** will be at Vilnius University's Aula Parva Café.
- **Optional free one-hour tours of Vilnius University**. Participants joining the tours are kindly asked to gather in the courtyard of the Central Campus, near the Kristijonas Donelaitis monument, where the guides will be waiting at **12:45**. Attendees may choose between a guided tour of the Vilnius University Library or the central architectural ensemble of Vilnius University.
- **Dinner**. The conference dinner will take place on the second floor of the **Grey** restaurant. The restaurant is located at 2 Pilies Street. The dinner will start at **19:30** local time.

## Saturday | May 24

### (Second Day of the Conference)

- **Venue & Coffee breaks**. The second day of the conference will be held at the same venue at **Vilnius University's Central Campus, in the Aula Parva Hall** (3 Universiteto Street, Vilnius). Coffee breaks will also be served at the same location as the previous day, in the **Aula Parva Café at Vilnius University**.
- **Lunch** is self-organized. Many restaurants and cafés are within walking distance of the conference venue, at Pilies Street in particular. Recommended options include: *Etno Dvaras* (16 Pilies Street), which offers a variety of traditional Lithuanian dishes; *Grey* (2 Pilies Street), known for its high-quality dining experience, comfort food and some traditional cuisine; *7 Fridays Pilies* (11 Pilies Street) – a traditional Vilnius University pub with a inner open-air yard and nice simple food; and *Pirmas Blynas* (15 Savičiaus Street), a social enterprise pancake café just an 8-minute walk from the venue.
